Learn, Understand and Grow with Your Child!

The Parent Education Program is based on the premise that learning is a natural ongoing process. Classes are designed to train parents to create supportive and positive learning environments for their children that will stimulate their physical, intellectual, social and emotional growth. This is done through participation, observation and discussion. The curriculum is a readiness program that includes pre-reading, math concepts, science, music and motor skill development, in addition to various parenting topics. Children and parents learn together.

Due to limited enrollment, registration is on a first come, first served basis. Online Spring registration begins November 13 at 9:00 am. Onsite Spring registration will start on November 13 at 8:00 am at the Cuesta site, 12254 Cuesta Drive, Cerritos. (See map toward the back of brochure.)

*Choose your classes carefully! There will be a charge of \$5 to transfer or \$10 processing fee to drop a class before the first day of class.

No refunds will be given after the first class meeting.

The adult is the student so the person that will be bringing the child is the one that should be enrolled.

Requirements for Registration

It is NOT necessary for children to be potty trained. Children must meet the age requirement of the class. Second adult from the same family must register in the Cuesta office in order to get the 2nd adult discount. FEE FOR THE SECOND ADULT WILL BE \$40 PER SEMESTER.

Immunization

Proof of current immunizations is required before a child may attend a Parent Education class. The immunizations required for school enrollment are: DPT or DT, MMR, Hepatitis B, Hib and Varicella. Adult must have proof of Pertussis, Measles and Influenza Immunity and a current Tuberculosis clearance.

Registration Fee

2 hour per week online classes = \$57 per Semester
2.5 hour per week online classes = \$72 per Semester
2 hour per week classes \$72 + \$10 material fee = \$82 per Semester
2.5 hour per week classes \$90 + \$10 material fee = \$100 per Semester
3 hour per week classes \$108 + \$10 material fee = \$118 per Semester
4 hour classes \$192 + \$20 material fee = \$212 per Semester
4 hour classes are limited to 15 students.

6 hour per week classes \$216 + \$20 material fee = \$236 per Semester
7 hour per week classes \$252 + \$20 material fee = \$272 per Semester
9 hour per week classes \$324 + \$30 material fee = \$354 per Semester
10.5 hour per week classes \$348 + \$30 material fee = \$378 per Semester

NOTE: \$10 - \$30 material fee is per child. An additional fee will be charged for an extra child and this fee will be collected in class on the first day.

Important Policies

- All adults attending class must be registered. This is not negotiable.
- All children must be accompanied by a <u>registered</u> adult.
- A <u>second adult</u> may register at a reduced fee. This registration must be done at the <u>Cuesta office</u>.
- A <u>visitor</u> must fill out the required forms and may stay to <u>observe</u> only for up to 30 minutes.
- An adult that would like to <u>participate</u> in an <u>entire class</u> may do so by filling out the appropriate forms and paying a \$5 fee. This <u>guest</u> must be accompanied by a <u>registered adult</u>.
- All students must sign waiver forms that apply to scheduled classroom time and field trip activities.

CAREER PATH TECHNICAL DIPLOMA PROGRAMS

Earn a Career Path Vocational Diploma!

Earn a Career Path Technical Diploma by taking a prescribed number of professional courses directed to specific careers. The Career Path Technical Diploma is designed to verify to business and industry that you have the skills required for entry-level positions. *The ABC Adult Education Program is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC), and the Council on Occupational Education (COE)*, and exclusively employs State of California certificated teachers and qualified consultants.

- The order of the classes is the suggested sequence. Some classes may be taken concurrently.
- When the Career Program core classes are completed, additional classes may be added if time permits.
- To qualify for a course certificate, students must get a passing grade of 70% or better and attend class according to the course syllabus (at least 90% of the scheduled time).
- To qualify for a diploma all attendance must add up to the total number of hours required for the program.
- Not all classes are offered each nine-week session.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The enrollment of concurrent high school students in Adult Education classes is subject to the limitations imposed by Section 52500.1 of the California Education Code. Each of the following conditions must be met:

- (1) There must be a conference involving the student, the high school counselor and the student's parent or guardian.
- (2) There must be written documentation of the conference.
- (3) There must be a statement that the student is voluntarily enrolling in the Adult Education class and that the enrollment form is to be placed in the student's cumulative file.

Students must bring a completed Concurrent High School Enrollment Form, a copy of their current class schedule and a high school photo I.D. to enroll. Hours are Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm and Friday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. The completed enrollment form must bear the signatures of the high school counselor, the parent or guardian, and the student to certify that the above conditions have been met.

(Concurrent High School Enrollment Forms are available at each of the district high schools in the counseling offices. Enrollment is contingent upon full-time enrollment at the high school.)

Concurrent high school students may not take adult education in any of these areas: (1) Adults with Disabilities, (2) Apprenticeships, (3) Parent Education, (4) Enrichment, and (5) Fitness.

Enrollment of high school concurrent students is limited to residents of the ABC Unified School District. Concurrent students living outside of the district are not eligible to enroll in the ABC Adult School.

INSURANCE

ABC Adult School does not provide medical insurance coverage for students. Medical insurance is a student responsibility

NOTICE TO PARENTS OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

All adult school classes meet in portable facilities that do not meet the new earthquake safety requirements of the Field Act (Rev. 9/89). Adult education classes meet at various locations throughout the community. Transportation to and from these classes is the responsibility of the student and/or the parent/guardian. The ABC Unified School District is not liable for the safety or for the transportation of students that attend classes in these facilities.

ONLINE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Online registration is convenient, easy and no extra charge. Simply click on the online link. Once you are on the welcome page, simply follow the online prompts.

PARKING (HANDICAPPED PARKING)

On campus parking is available at no charge. Handicapped parking is available. **Students park at their own risk.**

Parking at ABC Adult School is free, however, we do have a few simple rules for the safety and convenience of our students and staff:

- Please obey signs, directional arrows and NO PARKING areas including fire lane markings.
- Parking spaces marked STAFF are for employees only. No students or visitors are to park in these spaces. It is imperative that teachers and staff are able to park and get to their assigned classes on time.
- Visitor parking spaces are available near the Adult School office for 20 minute parking. Other parking is available on the street or in the marked lots adjacent to and across from Cuesta Drive.
- Observe the 5 miles per hour speed limit. Bicycles must be locked in bike racks and are not permitted in buildings. Do not ride bicycles on campus.
- Head in parking only.
- Parking code violations can result in ticketing and/or towing of your vehicle.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Students must go to the Assessment Center to complete the pre-assessment prior to attending classes.
- Due to limited capacity in assessment rooms, arrive early to ensure your space
- Students who do not meet the basic skill level requirement for the CTE Program will be referred to a counselor to discuss options.
- Students must be 18 years of age or older to enroll in any program.
- Childcare is not available at ABC Adult School.
- Test times and locations are subject to change without notice.
- No minors are allowed without parental/adult supervision in the Assessment Center or on any of our campuses.

REFUND POLICY

ABC Adult School follows a fair and equitable refund policy for the refund of fees and other institutional charges as adopted by the Council on Occupational Education (COE). Refunds are given if the class is canceled. If the student requests a refund, it must be prior to the second class meeting, whether attended or not. Student initiated refunds will be reduced by a \$10 service charge for each class. To receive a refund, students request a refund form from the Front Office. Once the form is completed by the student and an explanation is provided, it must be approved by the Administrator. Once approved, the refund request form is sent to the ABC Adult School Accounting Office where the refund is processed. The refund check is then mailed to the student. The process may take up to six weeks. No refunds will be given for missed classes, insurance fee, books, materials fee, equipment or cosmetology/barbering kits.

REFUND POLICY

There are 3 types of refunds processed through ABC Adult School:

- Non-Program Students NOT officially enrolled in a CTE program, ESL, Academics and Older Adults Individual Course Refunds and Community Education
- CTE Program Students Program withdrawal (students officially enrolled in a program)
- CTE Program Students Course withdrawal (students officially enrolled in a program)

Non - Program Students

Students who enroll in a non state funded community education course or do not enroll in a program of study are subject to the following refund policy:

ABC Adult School will refund class and lab fees if a regular class is cancelled by ABC Adult School. Individual requests for refunds must be made at the Adult School office prior to the second class meeting or within two weeks of registration. ABC Adult School reserves the right to cancel any class due to low or declining enrollment.

Students in Community Education classes must decide by the start of the second session whether they wish to continue in the class. NO REFUNDS for Community Education Class will be given after the start of the second session. Student initiated drops and refund requests are subject to a \$10 per class processing fee (or up to \$10 if the class is less than \$10).

It is the student's responsibility to apply for a refund. A student is eligible for a refund after classes have been officially dropped, within the refund policy timeline. Classes must be dropped by the appropriate deadline for the session in order to be eligible for a refund. To request a refund, please go to the office before the second class meeting begins, drop the class and fill out the Refund Request Form. The refund request form is also available online at ABCAdultSchool.edu and can be mailed to the Main Office (Cuesta or Cabrillo campus). It must be postmarked by the appropriate deadline. Stated deadlines are not adjusted due to late enrollment.

If a student paid by credit or debit card and the student has their receipt, an electronic refund will be made to their credit or debit card. Any other form of payment will be refunded by check. Approved refunds will be mailed in approximately four to six weeks. Be sure your current mailing address is on file with the school. All refund checks are made payable to the student.

Community Education, ESL, Academics and Older Adults, CTE Individual Course Refunds (Students not enrolled in a program)

Students who enroll in an Academics, Older Adults, ESL Community Education or CTE individual course and are NOT officially enrolled in one of the 12 CTE recognized programs (enrollment in an official CTEC Program is done after meeting with the TOSA, Job Developer or Financial Aid Secretary and filling out a declaration form) are subject to the following refund policy:

ABC Adult School will refund class and lab fees if a regular class is cancelled by ABC Adult School. Individual requests for refunds must be made at the Adult School office prior to the second class meeting or within two weeks of registration. ABC Adult School reserves the right to cancel any class due to low or declining enrollment.

Students who enroll in an Academics, Older Adults, ESL Community Education or CTE individual course and are NOT officially enrolled in one of the 9 CTE recognized programs, must decide by the start of the second class meeting whether they wish to continue in the class to receive any

type of refund. Students who decide to drop before the first session begins will be given a refund less a \$10 processing fee per class. Students who cancel up to the start of the second class session can get a school credit minus a \$10 processing fee per class. NO REFUNDS will be given after the start of the second session. No exceptions. All student initiated drops and refund requests are subject to a \$10 per class processing fee (or up to \$10 if the class is less than \$10). A refund will not be processed if academic credit has been awarded for the class. Refunds are not automatically processed.

It is the student's responsibility to apply for a refund. A student is eligible for a refund after classes have been officially dropped, within the refund policy timeline stated in the paragraph above. Classes must be dropped by the appropriate deadline for the session in order to be eligible for a refund. Stated deadlines are not adjusted due to late enrollment. To request a refund, please go to the office before the second session begins, drop the class and fill out the Refund Request Form. The refund request form is also available online at ABCAdultSchool.edu and can be mailed to the Main Office (Cuesta or Cabrillo campus). It must be postmarked by the appropriate deadline as determined by the guidelines in the last paragraph. It is the student's responsibility to apply for a refund.

If a student paid by credit or debit card and the student has their receipt, an electronic refund will be made to their credit or debit card. Any other form of payment will be refunded by check. Approved refunds will be mailed in approximately four to six weeks. Be sure your current mailing address is on file with the school. All refund checks are made payable to the student.

Program Refunds - <u>Program Withdrawal</u> (Students officially enrolled in a CTE program)

Students may withdraw at any time during a term. Refund amounts will be determined by the formulas listed below whether or not the student is receiving financial aid.

We realize that outside circumstances may sometimes impact a student's ability to complete the program of study. When a student stops attending all of his or her classes, depending on the circumstances, it may be classified as a "withdrawal," or "dismissal" from the institution. For the purpose of charges assessed and financial aid eligibility listed below, a dismissal will be handled the same as a withdrawal from the Institution. Students who do not complete at least 60% of the hours of each pay period listed in the financial aid calendar, must repay the unearned portion of all awarded aid. This unearned portion is based on the total number of hours scheduled to be completed and divided by the total hours in the pay period (Title IV Refund Process below). Students must repay the amount received as an overpayment. Students who owe repayments or overpayments are ineligible for additional Federal and/ or State Aid. When learning of an over-award, ABC Adult School ("ABC Adult") will report the over-award to the funding source.

Program Refunds - <u>Course Withdrawal</u> (Students officially enrolled in a CTE program)

Students who are withdrawing from an individual course but not the entire program may withdraw at any time during a term. Refund amounts will be determined by the formulas listed below whether or not the student is receiving financial aid. If 60% or more of the course has been completed, there is no refund. If 59% or less of the course has been completed, the refund is based on the total number of hours scheduled to be completed and divided by the total hours in the course.

No refunds will be given for missed classes, insurance fee, books, materials fee, equipment or cosmetology/barbering kits.

Refund Policy-Fee-Based Community Education Classes

Make your decisions carefully, refunds will be given only if:

- a class is filled prior to receiving registration
- a class is canceled by the school

Allow 4-6 weeks for processing refund.

Return of Title IV Funds (R2T4) Policy

When a student withdraws or is dismissed from ABC Adult School, a determination of the earned and unearned portion of Title IV aid will be determined. The date of withdrawal or last date attended will be used according to attendance records generated by the School's Attendance System (ASAP). See Student Financial Aid section or the Financial Aid page on the website for further information.

RETURNED CHECKS

There will be a \$35 charge for all returned checks.

NO SMOKING POLICY

ABC Adult School has established a new Assessment Center which is approved as a Pearson VUE Testing Center and fully equipped for the Computer-Based GED test.


